I graduated in Medicine (7/1998) and granted Gastroenterology Specialty (11/2002) at Turin University, in Italy. During University and Gastroenterology Specialty School I worked as student and fellow at Mauriziano Hospital (Turin), where traditionally is situated the most ancient Gastroenterology Division in Italy, well renown for Inflammatory Bowel Disease diagnosis and management (since and before 1990s).

I worked as fellow in Gastroenterology and Endoscopy between 2001-2002 in Leuven, Belgium (under the supervision of Prof. Paul Rutgeerts) and between 2002-2003 in Oxford, UK (under the supervision of Prof. Derek Jewell). I led the SES-CD development study, and since then I extensively worked at standardization of endoscopic results in inflammatory bowel disease patients, with several educational courses developed and led in Italy under the IG-IBD educational programme.

Since 2012 I acted as off-site reviewer for Robarts Trials Inc (>150 readings, all Crohn CDEIS/SES-CD) and for Quintiles-Bioclinica (>400 readings, roughly 60% for UC -Mayo- and 40% for Crohn -SES-CD-) and as Central Review Board member for Genetech trials.


