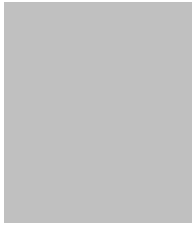

WORK AND PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

From 1988 to 1992

Clinical care activities with the II University Department of General Medicine for the 'Azienda Ospedaliera' San Giovanni Battista in Turin, directed initially by Prof. F. Gavosto and, from November 1991, by Prof. G. Gaidano, as an intern while preparing her thesis.

From November 1992 to November 1997

She practised in the same department as a trainee specialist in Internal Medicine, conducting ward, out-patient and Day Hospital activities.

From May to November 1996 and from May to November 1997 (total 12 months)

As part of the course in Emergency Medical Treatment for the Specialist School of Internal Medicine, she practised in the First Aid and Emergency Medical Treatment department (Prof. Gai) of the 'Azienda Ospedaliera' San Giovanni Battista in Turin. Here she practised on the wards and in the Accident and Emergency department.

September 1998 to March 1999

She has worked as a Level 1 Medical Officer in the following departments: General Medicine III, administrative/organizational department, Maria Vittoria Hospital (A.S.L. 3), practising on the wards.

From March 1999 to November 1999

Medicine IX – Accident and Emergency, administrative/organizational department, 'Azienda Ospedaliera' S. Giovanni Battista, Turin, practicing in the wards and the Accident and Emergency department.

From November 1999 to July 2001

General Medicine II, University Controlled Autonomous Operational Department (directed initially by Prof L. Chiandussi, followed by Prof G. Emanuelli), conducting ward, out-patient and Day Hospital activities.

From July 2001 to February 2017

General Medicine V, University Controlled Autonomous Operational Department (directed by Prof. G. Emanuelli), conducting ward, out-patient and Day Hospital activities.
She takes part on a daily basis in diagnostic activities of the Pulmonary Department (under the direction of Prof. C. Bucca), involving the performance of simple spirometry examinations, bronchodilatory tests, specific and non-specific bronchial stimulation tests, blood gas analysis, alveolo-capillary diffusions, and measurement of NO in exhaled air.
